2013 was yet another stellar vintage in Napa Valley giving me grapes of exceptional quality and excellent potential—Thank You Weather Gods! The wines show the true flavors of each varietal which make up these fabulous wines.

Cabernet Sauvignon is the star of the blend in this vintage. It is, quite frankly, wonderfully expressive of the mountains where the vineyards are located—in the Diamond Mountain District.

The color is beautiful and elegant. The aroma is full of gravel, graphite, tobacco, cassis, black currant, black cherry, plumb, licorice and star anise. These are what we get from the nose, let us know what you smell!

Entry is opulent with a lingering mid-palate and that subtle tannic finish that will allow you to savor the wine glass after glass. The tannins bright yet not overpowering. A perfectly balanced wine.

The more you linger over the rim, the more you glean of the weather and mountain soils that produced the grapes in the bottle, and the minimalist approach I took to make the wines. A true expression of terroir.

I keep making these wines to remind me why I love drinking wines. Hope you will enjoy our Left Bank as much as we do!
