



## Webster Cellars 2013 Left Bank

### The Vintage:

2013 was yet another vintage that the weather gave me excellent quality grapes, Thank You Weather Gods! The wines show the true flavors of the fruit which make up these fabulous wines. The Cabernet varietal is the star in this vintage's blend. It is quite frankly, wonderfully expressive of the mountains it comes from—the vineyards of the Diamond Mountain District.

### Tasting Notes:

The color is beautiful and elegant, the tannins bright yet not overpowering. Entry is opulent with a lingering mid-palate and a subtle tannic finish that will allow you to savor the wine, glass after glass. A perfectly balanced wine. The nose is full of gravel, graphite, tobacco, cassis, black currant, black cherry, plumb, licorice and star anise. These are what we get from the nose, let us know what you smell!

The more you linger over the rim, the more you glean of the weather and mountain soils that produced the grapes in the bottle and the minimalist approach I took to make the wines. A true expression of terroir. I keep making these wines to remind me of why I love drinking wine. They are balanced, bright, acidic and food friendly wines that I love to drink and that pair well with all foods.
