



## Webster Cellars 2013 Reserve

### The Vintage:

Reserve, from the Latin, to hold back (for future use). My Reserve is a true Reserve. I choose my favorite barrel of Merlot and one of Cabernet Sauvignon, select two special French oak barrels then lay the wine aside for an additional year in the back of the cellar and watch it sleep quietly. Then we blend in small amounts of Petit Verdot and Cabernet Franc. Voila! A true Reserve wine.

### Tasting Notes:

The nose reminds you of another time in life, things were easy, life was simple, love was in the air, or your mind, friends were gathered around and you were drinking a great wine with some great food. Smells of dark berries, black cherries, blackberries, boysenberries, morning coffee smells of rich dark pungent roasted berries. A little French vanilla, maybe, a hint of cacao.

All this and more are where this wine will transport you. Smooth yet tannic, soft yet ample, strong yet elegant. A wonderful wine. My best of 2013. Reserved for 3 years.
